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INTRODUCTION

Having worked on a number of projects in Co Roscommon, I attempted to produce a 'family tree' of the Anglican parishes in the county in order to understand how they had been progressively gathered into larger groups since the late nineteenth century. Using the standard reference works, I was unable to find or deduce a satisfactory answer for a number of parishes and decided to investigate further. That piece of work is nearly complete, but publication had to be delayed because of the recent restrictions and will have to wait until final checking in record repositories and on the ground is undertaken.

Whilst researching that topic, I also decided to transcribe all surviving registers of all the Anglican parishes in the county. I started with some of the smaller parishes and this is the tenth.

The following points should be borne in mind when using the transcript:

Dates All dates have been standardised as follows; day in numbers, month in three letters (abbreviated as necessary), year.

Index The index lists in alphabetical order all persons who were recorded as baptised, married and buried at Athleague over the periods covered by the surviving registers.

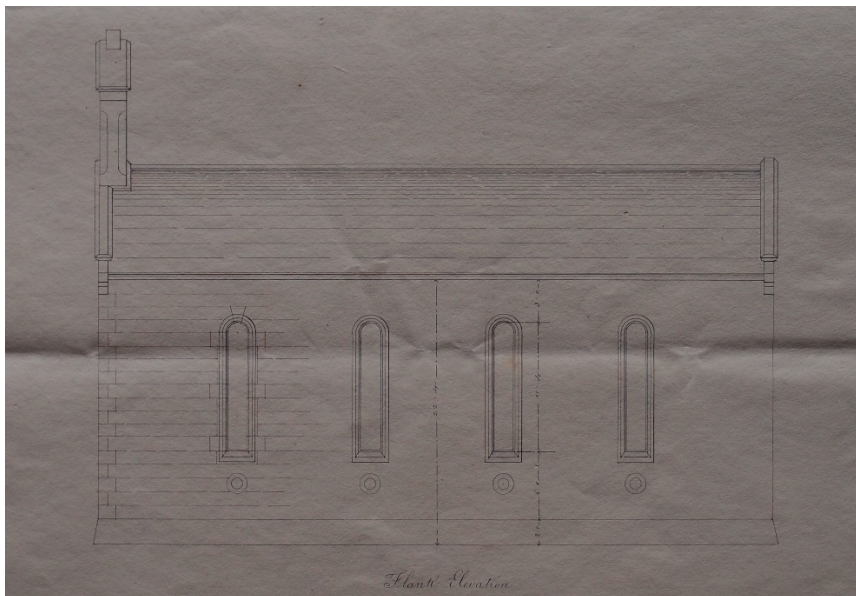
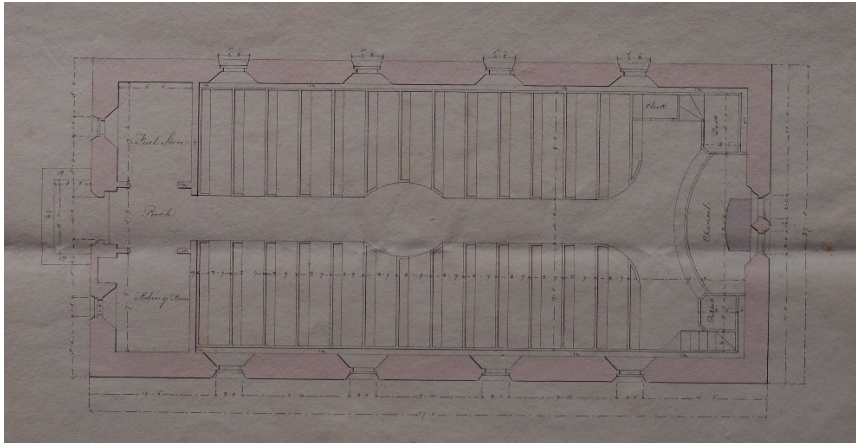

BRIEF HISTORY OF THE PARISH AND CHURCH

Athleague is an ancient parish of 13,000 acres on the south-western border of Co Roscommon with Co Galway, with one third of the parish in the latter county. It is crossed by the road from Roscommon to Loughrea. Athleague was a benefice in the Diocese of Elphin and included Fuerty (with a church) and Kilbegnet, from 1622 (according to Clergy KEA), or 1809 (according to Lewis), until 1837.

Athleague Church was described by Lewis as '*an old building in bad repair ... formerly a domestic chapel of the Lystre family*'. Fullerton concurred, stating that '*Athleague church is so old a building that the date and cost of its erection are not known*' and with a seating capacity of 100. This means that Fullerton, published in 1846, was describing the previous church, and the same church as noted by Lewis (published a decade previously), as a new church had been built in the early 1840s. The foundation stone was laid on 18 August 1841 (*Clergy KEA*) and the building was consecrated on 10 October 1843 (according to the list in the *Irish Ecclesiastical Gazette* of 17 March 1888). The plan and elevation below (by Joseph Welland) are dated 1843.



Athleague Church was closed in about 1975. It was subsequently used as a café and conference centre and more recently as the Suck Valley Visitor Centre. There are photographs of the church in *Clergy KEA* (p 152) and on the National Inventory of Architectural Heritage website (under Reg No 31822010).

Tessaragh (or Mount Talbot) was united to Athleague in 1873, as were Killyon and Castleblakeney (both Co Galway) from 1924 to 1931 and then Killeroran (Co Galway) from 1931 to 1940. Athleague was then held with St Peter's Athlone from 1936, before being united to the Roscommon Group of Parishes in 1941.

DETAILS OF THE REGISTERS

This transcript is based on the following registers.

Baptism Registers

The first one is a baptism register (P0731.02.1) containing:

Baptisms 1879-1936 (86 entries)

The page headers from the early 1880s usually describe the volume as covering Athleague and Mount Talbot (aka Tessaragh) Churches.

Marriage Registers

The second one is a marriage register (P0731.03.1) that contains:

Marriages 1845-1910 (27 entries)

Burial Registers

The third one is a burial register (P0731.04.1) containing:

Burials 1879-1979 (68 entries)

From the beginning of this register, the page headers describe it as covering Athleague and Mount Talbot (aka Tessaragh) and neighbouring Churchyards. The page headers from 1894 describe the volume as covering Athleague and Mount Talbot Churchyards. From 1936, the page headers describe the volume as covering Mount Talbot Churchyard.

One old copper collecting pan the gift of James W Lyster to the Parish of Athleague 20 May 1815.
