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INTRODUCTION

Having worked on three recent projects in Co Roscommon, I attempted to produce a 'family tree' of the Anglican parishes in the county in order to understand how they had been progressively gathered into larger groups since the late nineteenth century. Using the standard reference works, I was unable to find or deduce a satisfactory answer for a number of parishes and decided to investigate further. A volunteer living locally offered to assist and drew my attention to the existence of surviving registers for Aughrim Church, which was closed in the 1930s and demolished in 1955. As we had already collaborated on a previous project to record, map and photograph the gravestones in that churchyard, these registers seemed a natural choice for another transcript, as it would then enable researchers to cross-check family names in both documents. More projects in this part of the country will follow in due course.

The following points should be borne in mind when using the transcript:

Dates All dates have been standardised as follows; day in numbers, month in three letters (abbreviated as necessary), year.

Legibility and Spelling Indecipherable or uncertain details, whether due to illegible handwriting or faded ink, are marked by a ?

Missing Information A dash '-' is used to indicate that the expected information (name, date etc) is absent from the entry.

The Index The index lists in alphabetical order all persons who were recorded as baptised and married at Aughrim over the period 1879-1930. Where circumstantial evidence points to entries for more than one event for the same person, they have been included on the same line in the index. In the absence of any such evidence they have been listed separately.

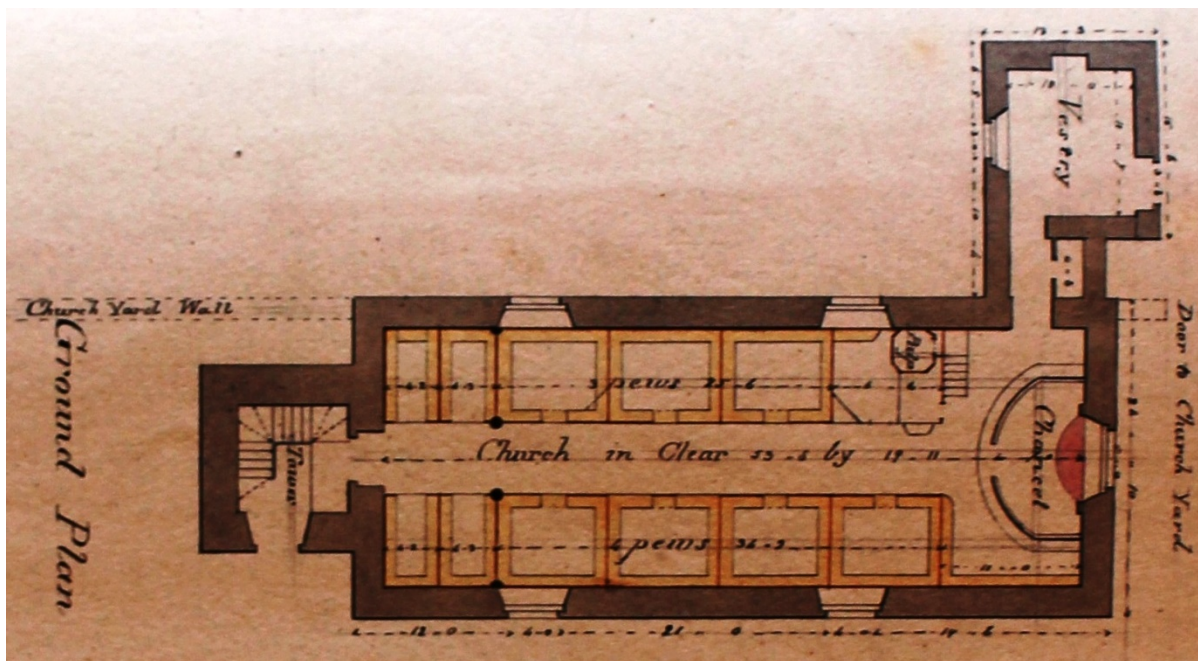

BRIEF HISTORY OF THE PARISH AND CHURCH

Aughrim is an ancient parish in Co Roscommon, 3½ miles south of Carrick-on-Shannon, on the road from Drumsna to Elphin and on the River Shannon. It comprises some 5535 acres (5316 titheable) and was previously known as Tirebrine. The living was a vicarage in the Diocese of Elphin, with the rectory forming the corps of the prebend of Tirebrine in the Cathedral Church of Elphin. In 1811 it was united with the rectory and vicarage of Cloonaff and the vicarage of Killumod to form the Aughrim Union. From 1848 it was joined with Killukin parish, and from about 1884 with Kilmore.

The church was built in 1744 in the townland of Ardlougher. It was described by Lewis in 1837 as a neat plain building with a small spire, having been recently repaired by a grant of £154 from the Ecclesiastical Commissioners. There was no glebe-house. The ruins of the old church in the townland of Aughrim, in which some of the Earls of Roscommon were buried, were also visible at that time. This is the Welland drawing of the floorplan in the 1850s.



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Aughrim Church was closed, temporarily at first in 1933, and then permanently. Its demolition in September 1955 was reported in the Roscommon Herald.

Baptism Registers

The first one is a baptism register containing:

There are no entries between 1891 and 1925.

Marriage Registers

The second one is a marriage register that contains:

Marriages 1885-1910 (5 entries)

These registers are held by the Rector of the South Leitrim Group of Parishes. Although there are gravestones in Aughrim Churchyard dating from the late 19th and early 20th centuries, the burial register does not seem to have survived. See 'The Memorial Inscriptions of Aughrim Churchyard' (2016) for further details. These burials might have been recorded elsewhere.

The earlier parish registers were lost in the destruction of the Four Courts in 1922. According to the IFHS register list they covered:
