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## INTRODUCTION

Whilst working on various Co Roscommon projects, my attention was drawn to a transcript of baptisms conducted in the early decades of the 19<sup>th</sup> century for Ballymascanlan Parish in Co Louth. The registers of this Parish were lost in the destruction of the Four Courts in 1922. According to the IFHS register list they covered:

Baptisms 1801-1897  
Marriages 1805-1845  
Burials 1817-1897

Thus the transcript in question covers the baptisms (with some marriages, one burial and some miscellaneous information) for the first half of the period covered by the lost registers. It has been deposited at the Representative Church Body Library, but I decided to transcribe the entries to make its existence more widely known and the genealogical information it contains more readily available.

The following points should be borne in mind when using the transcript:

Dates All dates have been standardised as follows; day in numbers, month in three letters (abbreviated as necessary), year.

Legibility and Spelling Indecipherable or uncertain details, whether due to illegible handwriting or faded ink, are marked by a ?

Missing Information A dash '-' is used to indicate that the expected information (name, date etc) is absent from the entry.

Chronological Discrepancies Entries out of chronological order by more than a week or so are in *italics*.

Additional Information Marginal notes and comments from the Registers appear in the text or as footnotes.

The Index The index lists in alphabetical order all persons who were recorded as baptised and married at Ballymascanlan over the period 1801-1844. Where circumstantial evidence points to entries for more than one event for the same person, they have been included on the same line in the index. In the absence of any such evidence they have been listed separately.

## BRIEF HISTORY OF THE PARISH AND CHURCH

Ballymascanlan is an ancient parish in Co Louth, 2 miles NE from Dundalk, which derives its name from the Scanlan sept. It is situated on the northern shore of Dundalk Bay and is crossed by roads from Dublin to Belfast and from Carlingford to Newry. The living was an inappropriate curacy in the Diocese of Armagh. Having been abbey land, the parish was tithe-free and the incumbent was paid an annual stipend by the rectorial impropiator.

The church was substantially rebuilt in 1819 with a loan of £550 from the late Board of First Fruits and a subsequent grant of £300. It was repaired in 1836 with a grant of £256 from the Ecclesiastical Commissioners. The bell from St John's Church, Louth was rehung in Ballymascanlan Church in 1950.

The original glebe house was built at Jenkinstown in 1781, about 2¼ miles from the church. A new glebe house was built at Ravensdale in 1825 and enlarged in 1850. Then a new rectory at Mount Pleasant was purchased in 1966. The incumbent of the Ballymascanlan Group of Parishes resided in Jonesborough Rectory between 1974 and 1989. In 1990 a new rectory was purchased at Lower Faughart, Dundalk.

### LINKED PARISHES

**Carlingford** (Co Louth): Holy Trinity Church renovated about 1813, **closed**, deconsecrated 1991, leased to Carlingford Lough Heritage Trust.

**Rathcor** Chapel of Ease (commonly called **Bush** Church) in Carlingford Parish: built 1844, renovated and dedicated to St Andrew 1994, communion table transferred from Carlingford Church 1996.

**Greenore** - Chapel of Ease in Carlingford Parish: consecrated and dedicated to St Patrick 1912, **closed**, sold 1968.

Carlingford grouped with Ballymascanlan in 1966.

**Omeath** (Co Louth) - Chapel of Ease in Carlingford Parish: consecrated and dedicated to St Andrew 1838, Proprietary Church until separate parish created at Disestablishment, chancel added about 1890, **closed** 1990, deconsecrated 1992, sold. Woodhouse family memorials transferred to Bush Church. Omeath grouped with Carlingford in 1945.

**Jonesborough** (Cos Armagh and Louth): formed from Killeavy 1760, enlarged from Ballymascanlan 1861. Church built about 1732, rebuilt 1772, consecrated 1785, repaired 1812, rebuilt 1866, **closed**, deconsecrated 1991, sold 1992. Jonesborough grouped with Ballymascanlan in 1934.



**Forkill** (sometimes Forkhill, Co Armagh): formed from Killeavy and Loughgilly 1760. Church built 1772, consecrated 1785, repaired 1812, improved 1859, **closed** 1990, deconsecrated 1991, sold 1995. Forkill grouped with Jonesborough 1920-1934, with Creggan 1934-1973, with Ballymascanlan in 1973.

**Killeavy** (sometimes Killevey, Killevy or Kilsleve, Co Armagh): divided amongst Camlough (Perpetual Curacy circa 1793), Meigh (Perpetual Curacy 1830), Drumbanagher (District Curacy 1845, separate parish 1872) and Mullaglass (District Curacy, separate parish 1872). Meigh absorbed into Camlough and Jonesborough but then recreated as a parish under the name of Killeavy in 1877. Killeavy Parish Church at Meigh built 1831, **closed**, deconsecrated, demolished 1973. Killeavy grouped with Ballymascanlan in 1973.

In summary, the other parishes in the present day Ballymascanlan Union are: Carlingford, Forkill, Jonesborough, Killeavy and Omeath, with churches at Ballymascanlan and Rathcor [Bush]. The Ballymascanlan Union is now part of the Dundalk Group of Parishes, with churches also at Creggan, Dundalk and Heynestown.

Camlough, Drumbanagher and Mullaglass are in other neighbouring groups/unions, each with a church.
