INTRODUCTION

Having worked on seven recent projects in Co Roscommon, I attempted to produce a 'family tree' of the Anglican parishes in the county in order to understand how they had been progressively gathered into larger groups since the late nineteenth century. Using the standard reference works, I was unable to find or deduce a satisfactory answer for a number of parishes and decided to investigate further. That piece of work is nearly complete, but publication will have to wait until the current restrictions are eased and final checking in record repositories and on the ground is allowed.

Whilst researching that topic, I also decided to transcribe all surviving registers of all the Anglican parishes in the county. I started with some of the smaller parishes and this is the second.

The following points should be borne in mind when using the transcript:

Dates All dates have been standardised as follows; day in numbers, month in three letters (abbreviated as necessary), year.

Index The index lists in alphabetical order all persons who were recorded as baptised and married at Castlemore over the period 1847-1911.

BRIEF HISTORY OF THE PARISH AND CHURCH

Castlemore is an ancient parish in the north-west of present day Co Roscommon, but it was originally in Co Mayo. Fullerton noted that:

'The Frenchpark section [2,100 acres, Co Roscommon] consists of 4 townlands, recently transferred from the Costello section [Co Mayo]'.

The remainder (6,800 acres) followed in 1898, under the provisions of the Local Government (Ireland) Act of that year. The parish includes part of the town of Ballaghaderreen (or Ballaghadireen), and is crossed by the road from Longford (to the ESE) to Swinford (to the WNW) and thence to Ballina.

The rest of the town of Ballaghaderreen is in Kilcolman, also an ancient parish, and originally located in three counties: Mayo (11,000 acres), Roscommon (1,600 acres) and Sligo (5,500 acres). Again Fullerton recorded that:

'The Roscommon section consists of the townlands of Banada and Keelbanada ... transferred from Mayo by the Act 3 and 4 Victoria c 76'.

The remainder of the Co Mayo section was also transferred to Co Roscommon in 1898 under the Local Government (Ireland) Act.

The benefice of Castlemore was a vicarage in the Diocese of Achonry and included the parishes of Kilcolman and Kilmovee (also in Co Mayo). The church, with a churchyard of just under one acre, was in Ballaghaderreen Townland. It was identified as land parcel 60 on Ordnance Survey map 74, but was listed as entry 190 of land parcel 59 in Kilcolman Parish (part of) in Griffith's Valuation.

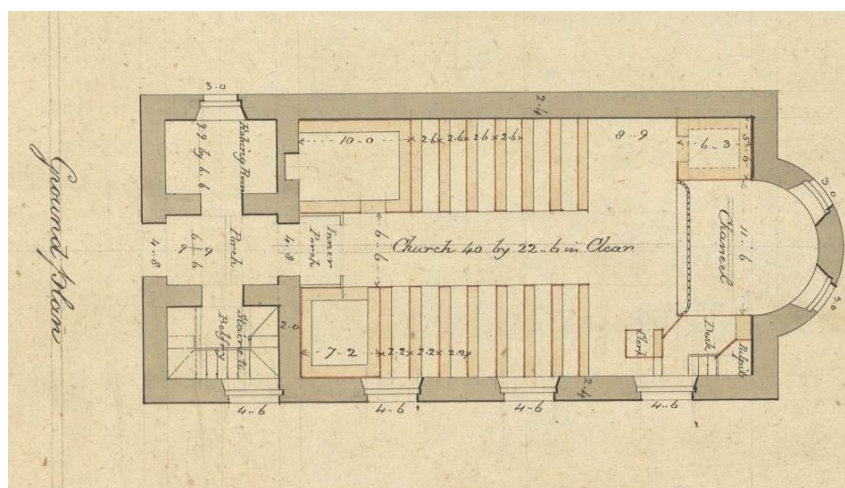
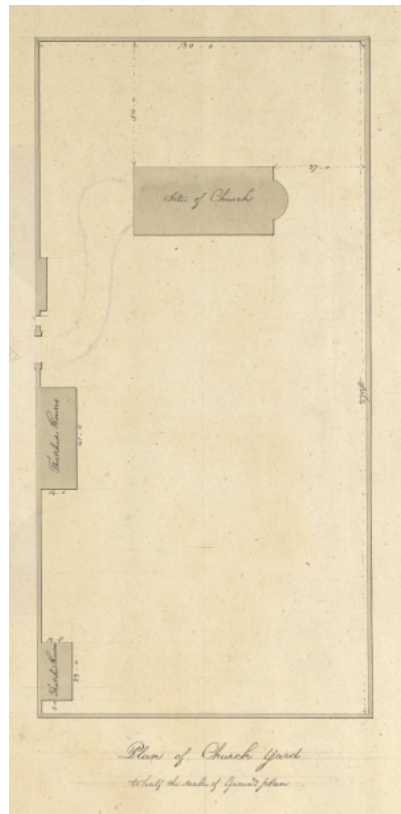
Both Lewis and Fullerton placed Ballaghadireen in Kilcolman Parish. Under Castlemore Lewis stated that *'The church of the union is at Ballaghadireen'*; under Kilcolman he confirmed that:

'The church in Ballaghadireen is a small building, serving for the vicarial union, and the Ecclesiastical Commissioners have recently granted £110 for its repair'.

Fullerton provided further details under Castlemore: *'The church was built in 1798, by means of a gift of £461 from the late Board of First Fruits. Sittings 200; attendance 40'*. Under Kilcolman he noted that *'The Mayo section contains the town of Ballaghadireen'* and then repeated precisely the same information about the church as in the Castlemore entry.

The website www.logainm.ie places Ballaghaderreen Townland in both Castlemore and Kilcolman Parishes. On www.townlands.ie Kilcolman Parish is in Cos Roscommon and Sligo and Ballaghaderreen Townland in the Co Roscommon portion of Kilcolman Parish. On that same website Castlemore Parish is in Co Roscommon and does not include Ballaghaderreen Townland.

The churchyard and church plans below by Joseph Welland date from about 1850:

Other architectural drawings of this church at the RCB Library are dated 1860. They show internal reordering and include an elevation.

As reported in the *Church of Ireland Gazette* of 13 February 1925, the Diocesan Council meeting on 3 February 1925 discussed ...

'the proposed sale of Castlemore Church, Ballaghaderreen. ... The sale of the material of the church, and the church yard, was recommended to the Representative Church Body, reserving the site of the church and that portion of the church [yard] in which there are graves, which shall be enclosed by a wall to be erected by the purchaser'.

Castlemore, Kilcolman and Kilmovee were united to Killaraght (Co Sligo) in 1889 and Killaraght (with Castlemore etc) was then united to Emlaghfad (Co Sligo) in 1925. Emlaghfad was subsequently united to Ballisadare (Co Sligo) in 1975.
