INTRODUCTION

Having worked on a number of projects in Co Roscommon, I attempted to produce a 'family tree' of the Anglican parishes in the county in order to understand how they had been progressively gathered into larger groups since the late nineteenth century. Using the standard reference works, I was unable to find or deduce a satisfactory answer for a number of parishes and decided to investigate further. That piece of work is nearly complete, but publication had to be delayed because of the recent restrictions and will have to wait until final checking in record repositories and on the ground is undertaken.

Whilst researching that topic, I also decided to transcribe all surviving registers of all the Anglican parishes in the county. I started with some of the smaller parishes and this is the twelfth.

The following points should be borne in mind when using the transcript:

Dates All dates have been standardised as follows; day in numbers, month in three letters (abbreviated as necessary), year.

Index The index lists in alphabetical order all persons who were recorded as baptised and married at Drimtemple over the periods covered by the surviving registers.

Parish Identification The church of the Oran Union was located in the village of Ballymoe, which is in Drimtemple Parish. All three names are used in the various source documents at different times.

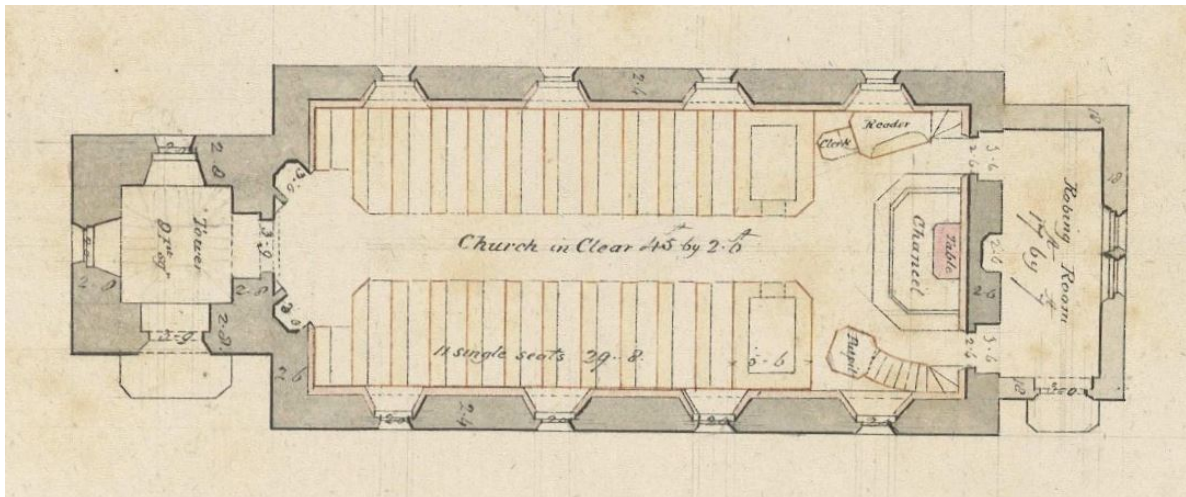

BRIEF HISTORY OF THE PARISH AND CHURCH

Drimtemple is an ancient parish of 7,500 acres in the central west of Co Roscommon, and also partly in Co Galway, with the River Suck forming the boundary between the two counties at this point. It is crossed by the road from Castlerea to Roscommon. It contains the village of Ballymoe in Durrow Townland in the Co Galway portion, with a bridge over the River Suck. It was a vicarage in the Diocese of Elphin, and formed part of the benefice of Oran.

Lewis stated that 'The church for the union is at Ballymoe, and was built in 1832 by aid of a gift of £900 from the late Board of First Fruits'. Fullerton concurred - 'The church of the benefice is in Drimtemple, and was built in 1832, by means of a gift of £900 from the late Board of First Fruits', and noted a seating capacity of 200. Oran Church was consecrated on 15 August 1833 according to the list of dates in the *Irish Ecclesiastical Gazette* of 17 March 1888.

The plan below is labelled Drimtemple Church and dated 1850. It is in MS 139 Welland Volume 1 No 53 at the RCB Library.

The church was variously referred to as Drimtemple Church or Oran Church or even Ballymoe Church. *Clergy KEA* states that the church was closed in about 1962. There is a photograph of the tower and roofless nave in *Clergy KEA* (p 213).

Clergy KEA is unclear on the parochial arrangements for Drimtemple and Oran from Disestablishment in 1870 until they were united to Kilkeevan, Tibohine and Loughglynn in 1920.

There is a gap in the clergy succession list for Drimtemple and Oran from Disestablishment in 1870 until union with Kilkeevan in 1920. By studying the registers, it is possible to suggest the following pragmatic arrangements. The Revd James Hunt may have continued to minister in Drimtemple Parish until the mid 1880s, in his capacity as Rector of Castleblakeney (Co Galway). From the mid 1880s the Revd Robert Irvine Ford may have done likewise, in his capacity as Vicar of the neighbouring parish of Kilkeevan, before formal union of the parishes. In the intervening 50 years, the officiating clergy are listed below under 'Other Clergy'.
