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## INTRODUCTION

Having worked on a number of projects in Co Roscommon, I attempted to produce a 'family tree' of the Anglican parishes in the county in order to understand how they had been progressively gathered into larger groups since the late nineteenth century. Using the standard reference works, I was unable to find or deduce a satisfactory answer for a number of parishes and decided to investigate further. That piece of work is nearly complete, but publication had to be delayed because of the recent restrictions and will have to wait until final checking in record repositories and on the ground is undertaken.

Whilst researching that topic, I also decided to transcribe all surviving registers of all the Anglican parishes in the county. I started with some of the smaller parishes and this is the thirteenth.

The following points should be borne in mind when using the transcript:

Dates All dates have been standardised as follows; day in numbers, month in three letters (abbreviated as necessary), year.

Index The index lists in alphabetical order all persons who were recorded as baptised and married at Loughglynn over the periods covered by the surviving registers.

## BRIEF HISTORY OF THE PARISH AND CHURCH

Loughglynn was an ecclesiastical district, 8 miles long and 6 miles wide in Tibohine Parish in Co Roscommon, on the road from Frenchpark to Ballyhaunis and containing the village of Loughglinn. It was established as a perpetual curacy in Tibohine Parish in 1819 and became a separate parish in 1845. Lewis (1837) described it as '*... a perpetual curacy ... in the patronage of the Rector of Taughboyne*' and Fullerton (1846) called it '*a quoad sacra parish, containing a village of the same name, in the quoad civilia parish of Tibohine*' and '*a separate benefice*'. Kilcorkey was united to Loughglynn in 1845.

Lewis noted the church as '*... a neat structure in good repair, built in 1815 by aid of a gift of £600 from the ... Board [of First Fruits] ... situated in the village*' and Fullerton agreed - '*The church was built in 1815, by means of a gift of £553 from the late Board of First Fruits*' with a seating capacity of 150. It was consecrated on 17 October 1819 according to the list in the *Irish Ecclesiastical Gazette* of 17 March 1888.

There are no plans of the church at the RCB Library and no photographs in the usual sources. Loughglynn Church was demolished in 1965. The site is to the W of Loughglinn, on the S side of R326 between junctions with R325 (to the E) and R293 (to the W). It is not listed on the Historic Environment Viewer under Glebe West Townland and there is no evidence of the building on the satellite mapping on the Griffith's Valuation (GV) website. The churchyard is not listed on the Co Roscommon Graveyards website and there is no indication of gravestones on the GV website.

Loughglynn reverted to chapel of ease status in Tibohine in 1871 and was then united to Kilkeevan in 1907. Kilkeevan (with Loughglynn) was united to the Roscommon Group of Parishes in 1977.
