Side 1 Inscription

Beneath the Cross
beside her mother's remains lie those of
her second daughter Charlotte Elizabeth Mills
who departed this life
the 23rd day January 1902
this much and only this we know
they are supremely blest
have done with sin and
care and woe
and with their Saviour rest

Side 2 Inscription

In Loving Memory
Of Revd Charles Edward Mills BA TCD
who for 47 years was Rector of this parish
respected and beloved
died 30th January 1909
aged 91 years
blessed are the pure of heart
Matt V. 8
until the day dawns
2 Pet 1. 19.
