## **Sermons of the Revd George Sealy, Rector of St Paul's, Cork (1794-1838)**

Collection of 108 individual handwritten items, mostly sermons, of George Sealy, primarily from his time as rector of St Paul's, Cork (1794-1838) although some items may be the work of another, more senior, clergyperson operating in the diocese of Cork, Cloyne and Ross at this time.

Ordained deacon by the bishop of Waterford and Lismore, the Revd Sealy was licensed to the curacy of Kilbrittain and Rathclaren, on 24 March 1780 and was ordained priest by the bishop of Cork, on 4 March 1781. The Revd Sealy would later serve the parishes of Inchigeelah (1791 to 1838) as well as St Paul's, Cork (1794 to 1838). He died on 29 May, 1838 and was buried near his wife, in the Abbey Church, Bath.

The sermons were donated to the RCB Library in 2022 by Rose Kempshall who had inherited a box of items relating to the Revd Sealy upon the passing of her uncle in Bath.

For the purposes of cataloguing, the sermons in this collection have been arranged chronologically by date. Each sermon (where the information is readily available) contains its title (in all cases, as it happens, this is the quote from the biblical verse on which the sermon is based), the Bible verse number as well as the location where the sermon was read, allowing a geographical picture of the extent of Sealy's preaching. Specific unique points about the sermon where they occur are listed in the 'notes' section.

Although the vast majority of the sermons presented in this collection are complete and finished works, we see evidence of extensive editing in some. Another interesting point to note is that some of the earlier works – notably before the Revd Sealy became a deacon, are in a different handwriting. This would suggest that the earlier sermons may have been the work of an older cleric, perhaps a mentor of some kind to Sealy.
