Notes: St Thomas' church, Marlborough Street, was largely destroyed by fire in 1922 in the course of which many of the parish records were fire damaged and some remain unusable. A new church was consecrated in Cathal Brugha Street in 1931, which, following the closure of St George's church in 1990, became the parish church of St George & St Thomas. The two parishes had been united since 1966 as one union of St George and St Thomas, hence the vestry minute books for the parish of St George and St Thomas (see P298/) should also be consulted from this date onwards.

The first parish register has been published as Raymond Refausse (ed.), Register of the parish of St Thomas, Dublin, 1750-1791 (Dublin, 1994).
